The Metroplex Passing Academy is a non-contact fundamental based camp for incoming 7th through 12th grader skill position players. This is a specialty camp designed to improve upon and develop the skills necessary in throwing and catching a football. The camp's purpose is to have players establish a foundation based on fundamentals, or improve on those already in place. All of the players in attendance, regardless of age or skill level will receive high quality coaching and repetition. The camp will have a 10 to 1 player to coach ratio; insuring quality repetition and coaching for all who attend.

WR Emphasis: Stance, Starts, Route Technique, Releases, Catching Technique, Body Positioning, Man to Man Concepts, Zone Concepts, Running After the Catch
